

TRACEABILITY POLICY

At Arlei Leather Group, traceability is one of our main axes in our line of work, to know the origin of animals, because we are convinced that animal care and welfare, together with the protection of native forests are essential for our work and to achieve safe and good quality products and reach business sustainability.

For this reason, we require that our suppliers, and their entire supply chain, guarantee traceability to demonstrate the care of bovines during the production process and the protection of native forests.

One of the purposes of this policy is to work together with our suppliers and government agencies, to achieve strict and verifiable animal welfare standards, aligned with the five animal freedoms:

- Free from hunger and thirst,
- Free from discomfort,
- Free from pain, injury, or disease,
- Freedom to express normal behavior,
- Freedom from fear and distress.

The other purpose of this policy is to guarantee that suppliers throughout the supply chain are not involved, directly or indirectly, in deforestation, conversion of natural habitats, appropriation of indigenous lands and/or protected areas.
